**SUBMITTING PROGRAM INFORMATION**

The ACB collects program information from approximately 150 participating bands and submits it to ASCAP and BMI at the end of each year as part of the sub-licensing agreement.

The easiest way to provide this information to both BMI and ASCAP is for you to send the information electronically. On the ACB website you can find a simple spreadsheet for you to use in compiling your 2008 program information and you would just need to fill in the spreadsheet and send it to programs@acbans.org at the end of the year (December or even January is fine).

The program information is needed for the composers and arrangers to be credited appropriately. Please include all works performed, including manuscripts and programs performed at free concerts or civic events.
